1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta Shall be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2. The Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats shall apply
- 1.3. The 2019 VX One Class Rules shall apply

2. ADVERTISING

2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen & supplied by the organizing authority

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all VX One class yachts
- 3.2. Eligible boats may enter by completing online entry at: http://vxone.org.au/index.php/events
- 3.3. Entries close 2359 Hrs13th October 2019
- 3.4. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the OA up until 2359 Hrs 24th October 2019

4. FEES

Required fees are:

Regatta entry..... \$100.00

Late entry.....additional \$50.00

5. MEASUREMENT

5.1 Hull and equipment may be inspected to ensure adherence to class rules. Sails may be checked to the class rules. Some tolerances in sail measurement may be accepted by the class measurer.

6. SCHEDULE

6.1. The proposed schedule shall be as following;

- 6.2. There shall be no warning signal after 1400 Hrs on the final day of racing
- 6.3. A minimum of four (4) races are required to be completed in order for a series to be constituted.
- 6.4. A maximum of seven (7) races are scheduled for this regatta.
- 6.5. No more than five (5) races shall be sailed in a day.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration. Sailing instructions may also be available prior to registration at: https://www.facebook.com/groups/2363852683890406/ (VX One Victoria Facebook group)

8. VENUE

- 8.1. The venue shall be the Metung Yacht Club Inc. 113 Metung Road, Metung VIC 3904
- 8.2. Attachment .1 shows the location of the club host club
- 8.3. Attachment .2 shows an approximate location of the racing area

9. COURSES

The courses shall be Windward-Leeward as-per the Sailing Instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-turns penalty is replaced by the One-turn penalty

11. SCORING

- 11.1. The 'Low Point System' of the 'Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix A' will apply.
- 11.2. A boat's series score will be the total of her race scores (no dropped results)

12. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 12.1. All competing boats shall carry a working VHF Radio with the capability to communicate with the race committee for the duration of racing in this regatta.
- 12.2. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions whilst racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restrictions also applies to mobile telephones.

13. HAUL-OUT

- 13.1. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
- 13.2. In-water berthing shall be provided for the duration of the regatta.

14. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st, 2nd & 3rd Scratch

15. DISCLAIMER



16. INSURANCE

16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy with a racing cover considered by their insurer as adequate for the risks involved with a minimum cover of AUD \$10 million.
